Dear Parents,

Welcome back! I hope you had a lovely Christmas break and are fully rested for the new term ahead.

Whilst the school has been closed, you may have noticed that we have installed a new electronic visitor system in our main reception area. This has been put into place to improve our safeguarding and emergency procedures. . If for any reason you are late bringing your child into school you will be asked to use this electronic system to mark your child present. You will also be required to use it when taking your child out of school for an appointment or if you are late collecting your child at the end of the day. By installing this system we will have an immediate and accurate report of which children, staff and visitors are in the building at any one time and we would appreciate your co-operation in using it when asked.

Our nursery used to keep a supply of spare wellington boots for outside play but the levels are currently very low. If you have any spare wellies ranging from sizes 7-11 that you are able to donate, it would be very much appreciated.

We are still receiving a high level of complaints from local residents with regards to parent parking. I would also like to remind you that it is illegal to park on the white zigzag lines near the crossing, even to drop off your child. These requests and reminders are being made to help keep our children safe.

In school this month we are thinking about how we behave towards other people who are different to ourselves.

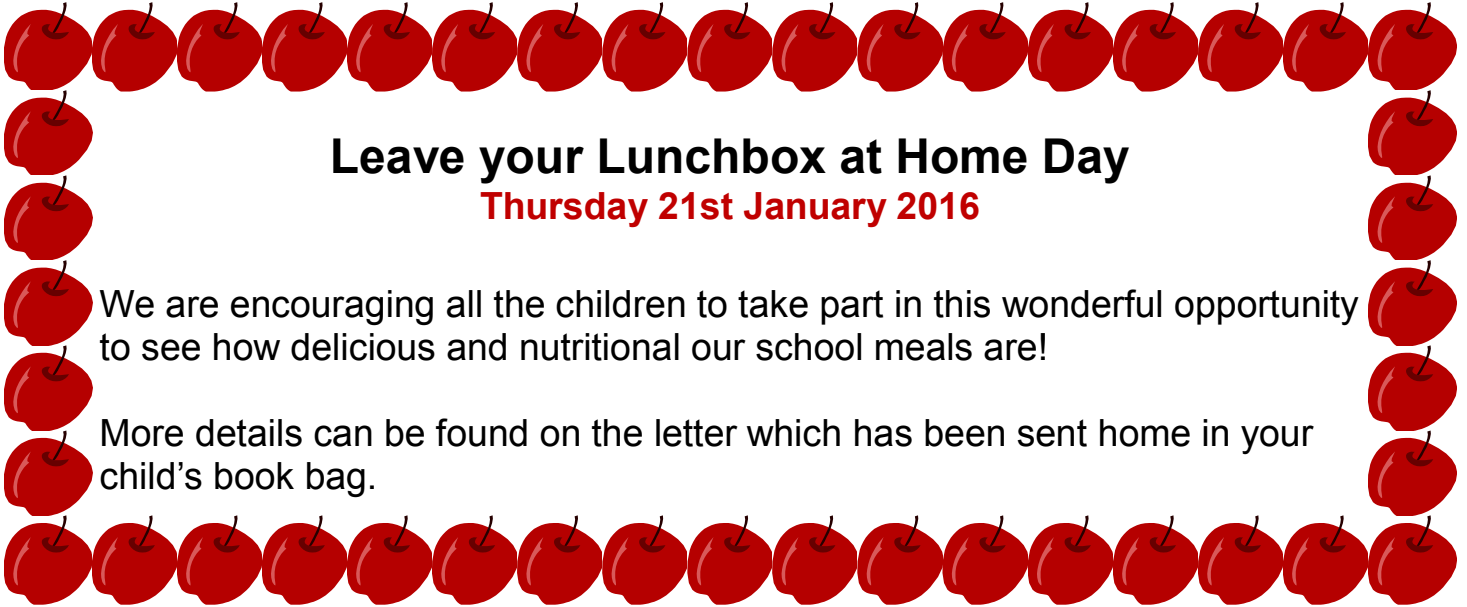

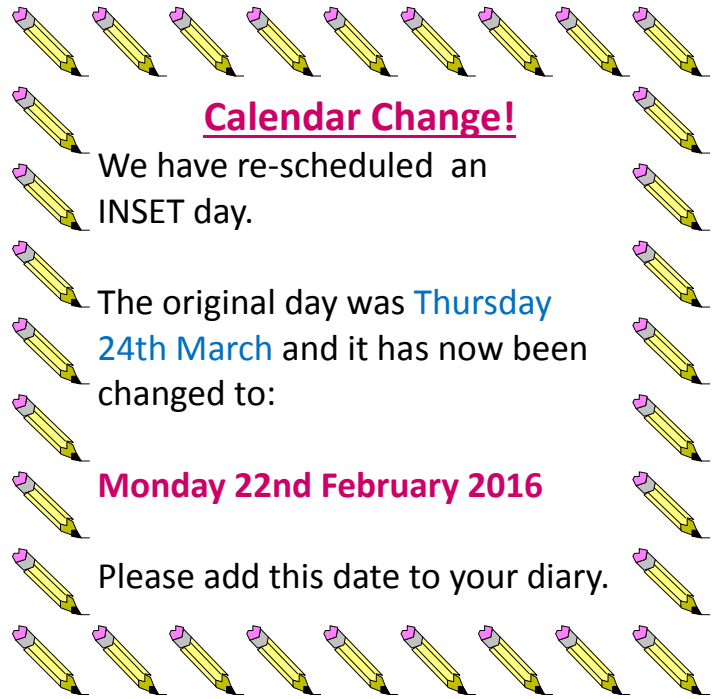
