This week has been all about science. Years 1 & 2 had an Olympic workshop on Tuesday where the children learnt all about bones and muscles in their bodies and how to make healthy choices. They also did lots of jumping jacks and other activities to get their heart rates up.

On Wednesday Year 3 had a live conference via Skype with a Commander from the National Space Centre. The children learnt all about living in space and they really enjoyed a question and answer session with the expert.

Year 4 took part in a healthy eating workshop on Tuesday and learnt about sugar swaps, food groups and the Eat Well Plate. Some parents then attended an assembly where they tasted food samples as well as hearing what the children had learnt.

Explore Learning visited Year 6 this week who enjoyed designing their own 3D shapes including an X-Box!

On Wednesday eight Sports Leaders from Year 5 went on a Sports Crew Training morning at Woking Leisure Centre. They learnt lots of new games which involved team work and each school demonstrated what they had learnt. Afterwards they had a discussion on why it is important to be a Sports Leader and they made information booklets before coming back to school.

All the children took part in a skipping workshop. They learnt to skip on one foot as well as backwards. They were also shown how to do the Double Dutch. They all had a great time and even some of the teachers and TAs joined in!

On Shrove Tuesday all the children enjoyed making and eating pancakes before taking part in a pancake race!
