Dear Parents/Carers,

Where has this term gone? On Monday, our staff training day was about our whole school priority reading. Teachers and support staff shared their favourite books, discussed reading habits such as folding down corners, skipping long descriptive passages, reading the end of a novel early on, etc. We talked about which two books would you take if you were marooned on a desert island and why? 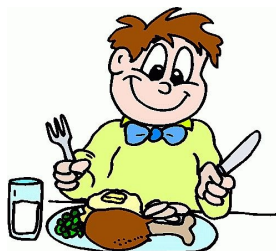
