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**School Dinners**

**ROAD SAFETY**

Please can we remind you that it is illegal park or stop on the zig-zag lines outside the school.

**Term-time Absences**

**Taking children out of school during term time is unacceptable for any reason other than illness.**

**Reducing absence from school is a key priority nationally and locally. Missing school seriously affects children's longer term life opportunities.**

**Surrey County Council considers that regular attendance at school is of such importance that**

**Penalty Notices (fines) may be used in some circumstances where unauthorised absences occur.**

**Penalty Notices may be issued in the following circumstances.**

**1. Pupils identified by police and Education Welfare Officers engaged on Truancy Patrols and who have incurred unauthorised absences.**

**2. Unauthorised holidays in term time. In such cases the Head of School/ Governing Body will request the Local Authority issue a Penalty Notice.**

**3. Where attendance has fallen below 85%. The parents' failure to engage with supportive measures proposed by the school and Education Welfare will be a factor when considering the issue of a Penalty Notice.**

**There is no statutory right of appeal once a notice has been issued, but on receipt of a warning you can make representation should you wish.**
