

If your child was born between 1st September 2011 and 31st August 2012 you will need to apply for a school place by 15th January 2016. The quickest and easiest way to apply for a school place is online.

Visit www.surreycc.gov.uk/admissions to access the application form and more information on the application process and admission arrangements for Surrey schools.


It is important that you consider this information carefully when you make your application.
